## SCHOOL UNIFORM AND THE SCHOOL SHOP

Schoolblazer are an online retailer – allowing parents to order anytime and from anywhere, at their convenience. **Delivery** is via DPD with a normal turn-around of 1-2 days, but with a firm promise of all deliveries within 3 working days. Urgent orders can be shipped in 24 hours using their Fasttrack service. DPD send a text message to confirm a delivery window, and delivery can be rearranged if not convenient. **Boarding pupils** are advised to order garments to School, please include your child's name and House on the order.

The Schoolblazer website has an "intelligent sizing system" to guide parents in size selection to help ensure that garments fit first time. On registration you will be required to input your child's sizes and the system will make a suggestion on size for the correct fit. The website guides you through items that you will require as uniform, and indicates whether items are compulsory or optional.

**Returns** to Schoolblazer (from the UK) are free of charge via the Post Office and they operate a 120 day return policy. Boarders should order items to be delivered to the School address, and if returns are necessary, House staff will help pupils with this.

# GIRLS' DRESS CODE SUMMARY

## FOURTH AND FIFTH FORM (Years 9, 10 & 11)

<b>BLAZER:</b>	School regulation navy blue
<b>SKIRT:</b>	School regulation ^skirt, to be worn mid-calf, unaltered, and as sold by the uniform supplier
<b>TROUSERS:</b>	School regulation tartan ^trousers, to sit on the back of the shoe. ^Girls have the choice of wearing a skirt or trousers, many do have both, but this is not essential and you may purchase whichever is your preference.
<b>SHIRT:</b>	Winter – School white shirt, fully tucked in, top button done up with tie Summer – School white blouse, fully tucked in
<b>TIE:</b>	School or House tie
<b>PULLOVER:</b>	School-crested regulation navy blue V-neck pullover
<b>TIGHTS:</b>	Unpatterned natural or navy blue (not black) tights or knee length navy socks
<b>SHOES:</b>	Smart and formal plain black leather flat shoes (no patent, suede or material), ballet, boot or trainer styles are not acceptable
<b>OVERCOAT:</b>	School regulation overcoat, worn with the School blazer
<b>ACCESSORIES:</b>	School rucksack/laptop bag or plain black bag/laptop bag (no logos) School maroon umbrella School scarf
<b>HAIR:</b>	Natural colour – no extremes of colour, cut or style, tied back fully, neatly and off the face. Hair bobbles, bands and headscarves in navy blue or maroon
<b>JEWELLERY:</b>	A watch One set of small stud earrings, to be worn at the bottom of the earlobe (no other piercings) No necklaces, bracelets or rings
<b>MAKE-UP:</b>	No make-up and only clear nail varnish
<b>SPORTS KIT:</b>	Only School sports kit to be worn on campus (see list below)

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## DRESS CODE SUMMARY - SIXTH FORM GIRLS

<b>TAILORED SUIT:</b>	Plain dark grey, navy blue or black No bold stripes or checks Jacket and skirt/trousers of matching material Skirt to sit on or below the knee (not tight) Trousers of a smart cut, not skinny, bootleg or jeans-style, to sit on the back of the shoe
<b>BLOUSE:</b>	Cotton fabric, plain white or light pastel shade (no dark colours) Collared 'shirt' style with buttons to the top - of an appropriate (not tight) fit, always tucked in
<b>PULLOVER:</b>	Plain V-neck pullover in black, dark grey, navy blue or maroon
<b>HOSIERY:</b>	Unpatterned natural, black or navy blue tights Natural, black or navy blue pop socks to be worn with trousers
<b>SHOES:</b>	Smart plain black leather or patent (no suede or material) Heels not more than 3cms in height (no stiletto heels), ballet boot and trainer styles are not acceptable
<b>OVERCOAT:</b>	School coat or plain tailored coat in navy blue, black or dark grey (to be worn over suit)
<b>SPORTS KIT:</b>	Only School sports kit to be worn on campus
<b>ACCESSORIES:</b>	School rucksack/laptop bag or plain black bag (no logos) School umbrella School scarf
<b>HAIR:</b>	Natural colour – no extremes of colour, cut or style. Hair accessories or headscarves in navy blue, black or maroon
<b>JEWELLERY:</b>	One discreet necklace, watch, bracelet and ring One set of small, unobtrusive earrings to be worn at the bottom of the earlobe (no other piercings)
<b>MAKE-UP:</b>	Subtle make-up and clear nail varnish

Any concerns or special requests can be discussed with your Houseparent /Senior Mistress or Deputy Headmaster Pastoral.

### All Sixth Formers need the following, available from the School Shop:

- School tracksuit bottoms
- School white polo shirt
- School showerproof training jacket/School fleece (or both)
- Girls - School maroon skorts

If pupils are selected for School teams, they may need to purchase kit and a School games holdall as advised by the PE department.

### COMMEMORATION

Commemoration outfits should be smart, formal, respectful and appropriate for Church. The outfit should be a skirt/dress/trouser suit or a jacket and co-ordinating skirt/dress/trousers. Jumpsuits and off-the-shoulder/strapless dresses/tops are not acceptable. Skirts and dresses should sit on or below the knee. Pashminas or cardigans are not appropriate. As this is a formal occasion, a hat or fascinator is allowed. Equally, this is an occasion on which some of our international students choose to wear their National dress, which is an entirely appropriate option. Please remember that the day involves a good deal of walking to different venues, so do make sure that shoes are of a comfortable height. Trainers or flip-flop styles are not appropriate. If you have any queries, would like to see examples of appropriate styles or would like to check the suitability of your outfit, please email the Senior Mistress, Miss Leech.

## DRESS CODE SUMMARY - SIXTH FORM BOYS

<b>TAILORED SUIT:</b>	Plain dark grey, navy blue or black No bold stripes or checks Trousers of a smart cut, not skinny, bootleg or jeans-style, to sit on the back of the shoe Alternatively, sports jacket and dark grey/black trousers
<b>SHIRT:</b>	Plain white or light pastel shade (no dark colours) Tucked in, top button always done up with tie
<b>TIE:</b>	School or House tie (School ties are available from Schoolblazer.com)
<b>PULLOVER:</b>	Plain v-neck pullover in black, dark grey, navy blue or maroon
<b>SHOES:</b>	Plain black leather (no suede, patent or material. Boot and trainer styles are not acceptable)
<b>SOCKS:</b>	Plain dark or formal coloured striped/patterned socks
<b>OVERCOAT:</b>	School coat or plain tailored coat in navy blue, black or dark grey (to be worn over suit)
<b>SPORTS KIT:</b>	Only School sports kit to be worn on campus, (see list below)
<b>ACCESSORIES:</b>	School rucksack/laptop bag or plain black bag/laptop bag (no logos) School umbrella School scarf
<b>HAIR:</b>	Natural colour – no extremes of colour, cut or style Neat, covering neither the collar nor eyes, no part of the hairstyle to be very closely cropped or shaven Clean shaven
<b>JEWELLERY:</b>	A watch A discreet ring, bracelet and necklace can be agreed with Houseparent

### COMMEMORATION

Shirts should be of a plain white or pastel shade (no dark colours). A School or House tie and a School boater or School Cap (if applicable) should be worn. Some of our international students choose to wear their National dress for this occasion, which is an entirely appropriate option.
